74.1% of academics rated learning outcomes in online education as the same, or superior to those in face-to-face instruction®



In 2012, nearly 63% of U.S. colleges offered fully-online degree programs.³ That's almost double what it was a decade earlier, at just 32.5%.




Nearly 70% of online education occurs within the traditional nonprofit sector.4




